

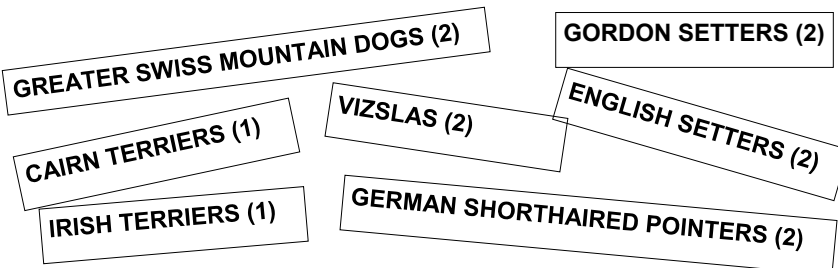

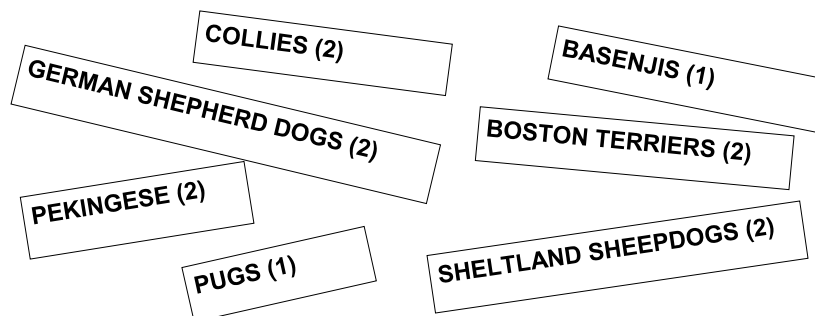

## Routes to the Event Site

Show Signs are Restricted

I-95 Exit #16, go South ~ Follow Blue Signs for "Beach Area"

Enter EXHIBITOR GATE ONLY for ALL EVENTS

### FROM ROUTE 95 - Exit #16 EAST NORWALK, CT

Go South on East Ave. (1/2 mile). Left on Van Zandt, after cemetery (Rt. 136) then right on Gregory for 1/2 mile. Left on Marvin at Fifth St., immediate right onto Calf Pasture Beach Blvd. (1/2 mile). Left on Canfield Ave. to Exhibitor entrance.

### FROM MERRITT PARKWAY & RTE. 7 CONNECTOR

Exit #39, take Rte. 7 South to Rte. I-95 North, one exit. Take Exit #16 South onto East Ave.

### OVERSIZED VEHICLES (12' - 14' CLEARANCE)

Rte. I-95, Exit #16. Go South on East Ave. **Prior to railroad overpass, turn right onto Fort Point St. to 2nd stop sign. Pass under the overpass (14' clearance). #### Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11, section 1.

The dog show rules are posted on the AKC web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>.

Most important are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor Class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf>.

#### SPECIAL CLASSES - See Individual Specialty Classifications

#### Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries– See Individual Specialty

**Brace** - Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated. "Brace #1". "Brace #2".

#### STUD DOG & BROOD BITCH CLASSES

The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch themselves may be altered, but not their get or produce.

**Stud Dog Class** • Will be for Stud Dog and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes. While the merits of the Stud Dog Are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed.

**Brood Bitch Class - Same as the Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.** As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes. Stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must BE shown. Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judges first in class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

# AKC National Owner-Handled Series Saturday & Sunday

*(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)*

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog.

***Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition at the regular show by an eligible owners. Professional handlers\*, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.***

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to the Best of Breed/Variety is eligible that dog will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to The Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dog other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring. The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional Handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

**Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs. • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs.**  
**Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs. • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs.**  
**Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs. • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs.**

### Master Class

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open. After the closing of entries for a show, they are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.** You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.
